

An extension of the Hungarian Spoken Language Database (BEA = BEszélt nyelvi Adatbázis) has been recorded with speakers of the age between 16 and 17 years. The protocol of the recordings follows that of BEA's with an exception of the three-speakers conversation, that was replaced with a task called "Pocket-text". In this task the speakers get random sentences at random points of the conversation that are to be integrated in their dialogue. The extension database was funded by the "Megújítás" tender of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. 18 speakers are recorded (9 female and 9 male students). The circumstances and the place of the recordings are the same as the case of the BEA-recordings. The sound files are transcribed in Praat in orthography (without punctuation) in intervals marked from pause-to pause.
